She is the Co-Chair of the Privacy Networking Group for the HIPAA Collaborative of Wisconsin (HIPAA COW) and most recently involved in a project to develop a sample policy on Breach Notification.

Cathy Boerner, JD, CHC has been supporting Compliance Officers, Privacy Officers and Security Officers over her 13 year consulting career.
